HARLOWTOWN MONT. FOURTY SIX DEGREES FOURTY SEVEN MIN. NORTH, ONE ONE  
ZERO DEGREES EIGHT MIN. WEST. THE OBJEXT WAS LIKD A LARGE STAR, MOVING  
VERY SLOWLY ANDISSAPPERING AND REAPPERING IN A DIFFERANT POSITION.
