The objects seemed to hover for periods then make quick starts and stops. A second object which was not mentioned in the initial report, was reported on the follow-up 164 to circle the first object three times then seemed to land.  The description of the first object is with no doubt a star/planet sighting. Jupiter (RA 5.21) is at <del>23</del> deg azimuth and <del>60</del> deg elevation at 2030L, and <del>at 2050L</del> at 2050L. Stellar mag -2.0. Therefore it is of my opinion that the observer was evidently confused in direction and was looking to the <del>East</del> <sup>south</sup> rather than the East. The second object was probably an A/C. However the data is insufficient to make an evaluation as such.  (2 Witnesses)

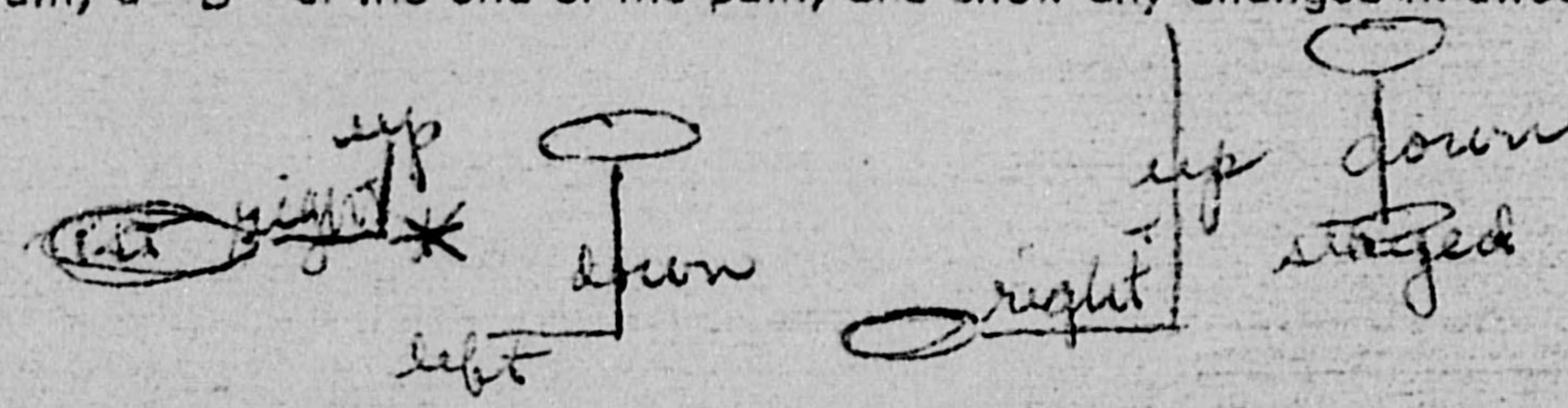

Brief summary which might be clearer:

Spotted UFO & succeeded in following it to landing point, approximately 3 miles away. When object landed, light colors had changed from red, blue & green to light-salmon color. It was a fixed light, did not flicker. UFO seemed to ~~float~~ move every 10 or 15 minutes & seemed to follow the pattern (example 2B). After approximately 30 to 45 minutes, the 2nd UFO left the landing point & we did not see where it went, ~~but~~ <sup>only</sup> ~~it~~ <sup>it</sup> ~~was~~ <sup>was</sup> in an easterly direction and then faded. About 30 minutes later, ~~the~~ 2nd or a 3rd UFO appeared from a south-easterly direction and circled the area. It came very close to ground (this is when I saw the shape of object). It then landed about 1 to 1 1/2 miles between the car & the 1st UFO. It was impossible to see the 2nd UFO because it was <sup>surrounded</sup> in thick trees. About every 10 minutes, object would flicker & then go off - color seemed white. A short while after (am not sure of time) the light of the 1st UFO went off completely. Friend & myself <sup>decided</sup> to leave, about 20 minutes later we returned & parked the car about 1/8 mile farther than we were. We stopped at that particular spot because ~~we~~ <sup>we</sup> saw a large light-salmon colored light & we assumed it was the 2nd UFO. We stayed there about 5 <sup>until</sup> minutes - it went off - about 5 minutes.
